- NITI Aayog has released fourth edition of the State Health Index for 2019–20 that provides incremental performance in health outcomes and status.
- Among the Larger States, Kerala, Tamil Nadu and Telangan a emerged among the best three performers in terms of Overall Performance at 1st, 2nd and 3rd rank respectively. Uttar Pradesh (UP) ranked at the bottom i.e. 19th.

- Gujarat has topped the composite ranking in the Good Governance Index (GGI), followed by Maharashtra and Goa while Uttar Pradesh showe d an incremental growth of 8.9 percent in the indicators.





• Delhi has topped the union territories category composite ranking. Rajasthan has topped the Other States (Group B) category in Judiciary and Public Safety, Environment & Citizen Centric Governance.

- The Uttar Pradesh government is set to launch the ambitious 'Free Smartphone Yojana on December 25, which is the birth anniversary of senior BJP leader and former Prime Minister Atal Bihari Vajpayee.
- Under the scheme, the state government will distribute smartphones and tablets to final year students of graduation and above

- Under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Ann Yojana, the Centre is providing five-kilogram food grains per person per month free of cost to all beneficiaries covered under the National Food Security
- The scheme is a food security welfare scheme that was envisaged by PM Modi to provide assistance and help mitigate the economic impact of COVID-19.



• The government will be incurring an expenditure of nearly two lakh 6000 crore rupees on Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana.

PM Modi launched development projects worth Rs 2,095 crore in Varanasi, UP

- PM Narendra Modi has laid the foundation stones of 27 developmental projects worth Rs 2,095 crore including laying of the foundation stone for Banas Dairy in his parliamentary constituency Varanasi.
- Banas Dairy Sankul at UP State Industrial Development Authority
 Food Park, Karkhiyaon, Varanasi will be built at a cost of about Rs
 475 crore and will have a facility for processing 5 lakh litre of milk per
 day.



- He also laid the foundation stone for Biogas based Electricity generation plant for the Milk Producers
 Cooperative Union Plant at Ramnagar.
- PM inaugurated the Union Education Ministry's Inter-University Centre for Teachers Education, built at a cost of around Rs 107 crore, and a teachers' education center at the Central Institute of Higher Tibetan Studies, built at a cost of over Rs 7 crore.

DPIIT launched Unified Logistics Interface Platform Hackathon "LogiXtics"

- The Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) has launched the Unified Logistics Interface Platform (ULIP) Hackathon –'LogiXtics' with an aim to crowdsource ideas to benefit the logistics industry in India.
- LogiXtics is organised by NITI (National Institution for Transforming India) Aayog and Atal Innovation Mission and supported by National Industrial Corridor Development Corporation (NICDC) and NICDC Logistics Data Bank Services Limited (NLDSL).



• Aim: To promote the Startup community, individuals or anyone with the strategic skills and domain knowledge of the sector.

PM Modi laid foundation stone of Ganga Expressway in UP

- **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** laid the foundation stone of the **longest highway**in India, the **Ganga Expressway** in **Shahjahanpur**, **Uttar Pradesh** to offer fast-paced connectivity in India.
- The six-lane 594 km long expressway will be built at a cost of about Rs 36200 crorewill connect the western and eastern regions of UP.

• The highway will pass through different districts of UP such as Meerut, Hapur, Bulandshahr, Amroha, Sambhal, Budaun, Shahjahanpur, Hardoi, Unnao, Rae Bareli, Pratapgarh and Prayagraj.

India's 1st International Arbitration and Mediation Centre (IAMC) inaugurated in Hyderabad, Telangana

- Chief Justice of India (CJI)Justice NV Ramana, and Chief Minister of Telangana K Chandrasekhar Rao has inaugurated India's First International Arbitration and Mediation Centre (IAMC) at Phoenix VK Tower at Nanakramguda, Hyderabad, Telangana.
- IAMC has been established to quickly resolve the issues that arise due to the Lack of sufficient judges. IAMC will settle commercial disputes and it will also look into the disputes of ordinary people.

Centre granted 'in-principe' approval for 6 Nuclear Reactors at Jaitapur, Maharashtra

- Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science and Technology Dr. Jitendra granted 'In-Principle' approval for setting up 6 Nuclear Reactors at Jaitapur in Maharashtra.
- The approval is for setting up 6 nuclear power reactors of 1650 MW each, making Jaitapur as India's largest nuclear power generating site with a total capacity of 9900 MW.



• Technical cooperation is provided by the French Firm –**Électricité de France (EDF).**

Cabinet cleared proposal to raise women's marriage age from 18 to 21 years

- Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister N arendra Modi has given its nod for proposal to bring uniformity in the minimum age of marriage for men a nd women, thereby, increasing the legal age of marriage of women from 18 to 21 years. The legal age to get married for men is 21.
- In this regard, a Bill will be introduced to amend the Prohibition of Child Marriage Act (PCMA), 2006, Special Marriage Act, 1954 and personal laws such as the Hindu Marriage Act 1955 in the ongoing winter session of Parliament (November 29- December 23, 2021).



7th India International Science Festival 2021 held at Panaji, Goa

- Dr Jitendra Singh, Union Minister of State (I/C) Science & Technology, inaugurated the 7th edition of the India International Science festival, IISF at Panaji, Goa held from 10th December to 13th December 2021.
- IISF is a joint program of the Ministry of Science & Technology, Ministry of Earth Sciences, and Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA), a swadeshi science movement of Bharat.



- **Nodal Agency** for organizing IISF 2021 was the **National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research**, an autonomous institute under the MoES.
- **Theme 2021:** 'AzadiKaAmritMahotsav' celebrating Creativity, Science, Technology, and Innovation for a prosperous India.

NTPC will set up India's 1st Green Hydrogen Microgrid Projects at Simhadri, AP

- National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) has awarded a project of Standalone Fuel-Cell based Micro-grid with hydrogen production using electrolyzer in Simhadri, near Visakhapatnam in Andhra Pradesh.
- It is **India's 1st** Green Hydrogen based Energy Storage Project and one of the largest in the world.
- India targets to become carbon neutral by 2070.



Durga Puja on UNESCO's 'Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity' list

- United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) has added Kolkata's Durga Puja festival to its 'Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity'.
- India now has 14 intangible cultura I heritage elements on the UNESCO list. Other Indian entries that were previously inscribed include Nowrouz (2016), Ramlila (2008), Yoga (2016), and Kumbh Mela (2017).
- UNESCO established its Lists of Intangible Cultural Heritage in 2008 with
 the aim of ensuring better protection of important intangible cultural heritages worldwide and the
 awareness of their significance.

First Drone Mela in the country was organised at Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh

- In Madhya Pradesh, the first drone fair in the country was organized at Gwalior.
- Gwalior Drone Mela was organized jointly by the Ministry of Civil Aviation, the Government of India, the Government of Mad hya Pradesh, and the Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FICCI).

Govt laid foundation stone for Maa Umiya Dham Development Project in Ahmedabad, Gujarat

• Union Home Minister Amit Shah laid the foundation stone of Umiya Mata Dham temple and temple premises under Maa Umiya Dham Development Project at Umiya Campus in Sola in Ahmedabad, Gujarat along with several developmental projects including a railway bridge.



- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has virtually attended and addressed the
 foundation stone laying of the project on 13th December 2021. He stated the Project as an example of the
 notion of 'SabkaPrayas' (Efforts of everyone).
- Umiya Mata is located in the center of Unjha in the Mehsana district of Gujarat which celebrated its silver
 jubilee in November 2009. They will be developed at a cost of Rs 1,500 crore on 74,000 square yards of
 land.

Askot Wildlife Sanctuary in Uttarakhand declared as Eco-Sensitive Zone

 According to the gazette of India issu ed by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), an area of 454.65 square kilometres around the boundary of Askot Wildlife Sanctuary in the Pithoragarh district of Uttarakhand has been declared as the Askot Wildlife Sanctuary Eco-sensitive Zone (ESZ).




- The notified area extends from 0 to 22 km around the Askot Wildlife Sanctuary.
- The Askot Wildlife Sanctuary was established to protect the endangered flagship species Musk Deer and its habitat. The Askot Wildlife Sanctuary is also known as Musk Deer Park.

PM Modi inaugurated Kashi-Vishwanath Dham project in Varanasi

- **PM Narendra Modi** inaugurated the first phase of the **Kashi Vishwanath Dham Corridor** The project is spread over **5 lakh square feet** and connects the temple premises to the **River Ganga**.
- Project is constructed at a cost of ₹339 crore and is done with a vision to create an easily accessible pathway
 connecting the temple to the banks of river Ganga. A total of 23 buildings will be inaugurated in phase 1 of
 the project.

PM Narendra Modi inaugurated Saryu Nahar National Project in Balrampur, UP

- The 40-year long pending project, Saryu Nahar National Project, is inaugurated by Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi in Balrampur, Uttar Pradesh (UP) on December 11, 2021.
- The outlay of the project is over Rs 9,800 crore, out of which more than Rs 4,600 crore was provisioned in the last four years.
- It will cater to the problem of water shortage mainly in eastern UP/ Purvanchal with assured water for irrigation to over 14 lakh hectares of land and benefit about 29 lakh farmers.



Geographical Indications Registry accepted proposal to grant Mithila Makhana GI Tag

- The Geographical Indications Registry (GIR) under the Ministry of Commerce and Industry accepted the
 proposal to rename Bihar Makhana or fox nut as Mithila Makhana and retain its Geographical Identification
 (GI) tag.
- It also suggested amendments in the brand logo to highlight its origins and protect the product's Geographical Indications (GI) rights.
- The Sabour based Bihar Agriculture University (BAU) initiated an application on behalf of the Mithilanchal Makhana Utpadak Sangh (MMUS) to name their produce as Mithila Makhana for the welfare of fox nut growers in the Mithila region.

Maharashtra topped the list of state with maximum of beneficiaries under Atmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana

- Maharashtra tops the list of states with maximum number of beneficiaries under Atmanirbhar Bharat Rojgar Yojana (ABRY). It is followed by Tamil Nadu and Gujarat.
- The government had launched ABRY to incentivize employment generation in Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO) registered establishments during COVID-19 for a period from October 1, 2020 to March 31, 2022.



Auto settlement of Employees' Provident Fund (EPF) claims was introduced by EPFO in Jan, 2020.

Cabinet approved Ken-Betwa River Interlinking Project

- Ken-Betwa inter-linking of rivers project has been approved by the Union Cabinet, which is chaired by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi.
- At 2020-21 price levels, the overall cost of the Ken-Betwa link project has been estimated at 44,605 crores. It will cover the states of UP and MP.



- The Union Cabinet has approved central support for the project in the amount of Rs. 39,317 crores, which includes a grant of Rs. 36,290 crores and a loan of Rs. 3,027 crores.
- The project will be implemented through a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) known as the Ken-Betwa Link Project Authority (KBLPA). The project will irrigate 62 lakh hectares annually, provide drinking water to a population of 62 lakhs, and generate 103 MW of hydropower and 27 MW of solar power.

Andhra Pradesh inked pact with UN-FAO & ICAR for sustainable agriculture

- An agreement on Technical Cooperatiosn Project has been inked by Andhra Pradesh Government with the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organisation (UN-FAO) and Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) to help the state farmers in adopting a sustainable agriculture food system.
- FAO will provide training to farmers, Rythu Bharo sa Kendram (RBK) staff, officials, and scientists on new technologies in agricultural allied sectors and training to farmers on best cultivation management practices.
- In 2020, Rythu Bharosa Kendram (RBK) or farmer support centres were set up in AP as part of an effort to weed away fake seeds, pesticides and fertilisers from the markets.

Karnataka & UNDP signed LoU as a part of 'Code-Unnati' to improve entrepreneurship & youth employment

- Department of Youth Empowerment & Sports, Government of Karnataka has signed a Letter of
 Understanding (LoU) with the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) as a part of the State-level
 initiative 'Code-Unnati' to improve the access to entrepreneurship and employment opportunities among
 the youths, including women.
- The initiative involves United Nations Volunteers (UNV) and is supported by SAP India Lab's CSR
 Strategies will be implemented in 4 districts of Bengaluru Rural, Ramanagara, Dakshina Kannada and Raichuru.

Uttar Pradesh holds the top spot in Total Registered EVs in India: Ministry of Road Transport & Highways

- During the Winter Session of the Parliament, Nitin Gadkari, Union Minister of Road Transport & Highways, informed the Rajya Sabha on the state of Electric Vehicles (EV) in India.
- As per the data release, India has a total of 870,141 registered EVs, with Uttar Pradesh (UP) holding the top spot with 255,700 registered EVs. UP is followed by Delhi (125,347), Karnataka (72,544), Bihar (58,014) and Maharashtra (52,506) in successive positions.

NITI Aayog to establish 1,000 Atal Tinkering Labs in J&K

- The NITI Aayog has planned to establish 1000 Atal Tinkering Laboratories in Jammu and Kashmir. Out of 1000 Atal Tinkering Laboratories, 187 will be established by the end of the financial year 2021-22.
- Out of 187 ATLs, 31 are being established across government schools of J&k while 50 will be established in several educational institutions like KVs, JNVs, and Private schools.
- Atal Tinkering Labs (ATL) is a sub-mission under the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) of the Central Government
 in India. It is the flagship initiative of AIM, that seeks to nurture an innovative mindset amongst high school
 students across India.

India Skills Report 2022: Maharashtra retained top position

- As per the 9th edition of India Skills Report (ISR) 2022, released by Wheebox, Maharashtra has retained the top position in the list o f states with the highest poll of employable talent followed by Uttar Pradesh and Kerala.
- Pune is the city with the most highly employable resources with 78% of the test takers scoring above 60 percent.
- As per the current edition, the overall employability in India has improved with 46.2% of the youth being found to be highly employable compared to last year's employability standing at 45.97%..





Haiderpur wetland in Uttar Pradesh recognized as India's 47th Ramsar Site

- The Haiderpur Wetland abutting the Madhya Ganga barrage, about 10 km from Bijnor in western Uttar Pradesh, has been recognized under the 1971 Ramsar Convention on Wetlands.
- Uttar Pradesh is now home to 9 Ramsar wetlands. The wetland, which is a part of Hastinapur Wildlife Sanctuary, has also been identified under Namami Gange, a central flagship, as a model wetland along the Ganga. With this, there are now a total of 47 such designated areas in the country.
- NITI Aayog launched "e-Sawaari India Electric Bus Coalition" with CESL & WRI India
- NITI Aayog has launched e-Sawaari India Electric Bus Coalition in partnership with Convergence Energy Service Limited (CESL), World Resources Institute, India (WRI India), and with the support from Transformative Urban Mobility Initiative (TUMI).

Gujarat became India's Largest Manufacturing Hub: RBI

Gujarat displaced

- In accordance with the data by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI), Gujarat has surpassed Maharashtra to become India's leading manufacturing hub. Its Gross Value Addition (GVA) in manufacturing grew 9% annually between FY12 to FY20 to Rs 5.11 lakh crore.
- In terms of manufacturing, Maharashtra is followed by Tamil
 Nadu with a GVA of Rs 3.43 lakh crore at 3rd spot, Karnataka in Country

 also aid in controlling dropout rates of SC students from class 9th to 12th.






Earth Station of Doordarshan Kendra inaugurated in Gorakhpur, UP

India will become 3rd largest economy in 2031 as per CEBR's World Economic League Table 2022

- As per the Centre for Economics and Business Research's (CEBR) World Economic League Table 2022, India was predicted to become the 6th largest economy (by overtaking France) in 2022 and become the 3rd largest economy in 2031.
- The annual league table also predicted that China will overtake the US to be the largest economy in 2030 (two years later than the forecast in 2021). The world economy is set to surpass \$100 trillion for the first time in 2022.

- India ranked 3rd among dope violators in the world with 152 (17 percent of the world total) ADRVs.
- Bodybuilding (57), Weightlifting (25), and Athletics (20) have recorded more number of dope offenders in India. Russia tops the list with 167 ADRVs, followed by Italy with 157 ADRVs. Brazil (78) and Iran (70) have ranked 4th and 5th respectively.



- As per the report 2022, India is now among the most unequal countries in the world with an affluent elite.
- The average national income of the Indian adult population is Rs 204,200. While the bottom half of the Indian population earns Rs 53,610, the top 10% earns twenty times more (around Rs 11,66,520). Top 10% and top 1% hold respectively 57% and 22% of total national income, while share of the bottom 50% has gone down to 13%. The ratio in the richest nation that is the US, is 1 to 17.



Asia Power Index 2021: India ranked as 4th most Powerful Country in Asia

- As per the Lowy Institute Asia Power Index 2021, India Ranked 4th most powerful country in Asia for comprehensive power out of 26 countries, with an overall score of 37.7 out of 100.

The US cited that "China's human rights ATROCITIES" is the main reason for its boycott. The US has named the boycott as "**Diplomatic Boycott**".
- Canada will also join the United States, the United Kingdom and Australia diplomatic boycott of the Beijing Winter Olympics over human rights concerns. The announcement came after the White House, the Australian government and the UK government confirmed diplomatic boycotts of the Winter Games in February to protest Chinese human rights abuses. China has vowed to react with "firm countermeasures."

- Mormugao is being built at Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd as part of Project 15B destroyers and incorporates several indigenous technologies.

DRDO successfully test-fired new generation ballistic missile 'Agni P'

- Defence Research and Development Organisation(DRDO) successfully test-fired its new generation Agni Prime (Agni-P) missile from a base at Dr APJ Abdul Kalam island off the Odisha coast in Balasore.
- The Agni-P is a new generation advanced variant of the Agni class of missiles. The surface nuclear capable ballistic missile with a range of 1000 to 2000 km.



The missile was designed and developed completely by the DRDO.

HAL signed Rs 2,400 crores contract with BEL for 83 LCA Tejas Mk1A fighters

- Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) signed a Rs 2,400 crores contract with Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) for development and supply of 20 types of systems for 83 LCA (Light Combat Aircraft) Tejas Mk1A fighter aircraft programme.
- The duration of the contract is 5 years i.e., from 2023 to 2028. Notably, this is HAL's biggest order on any Indian company thus boosting the 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' campaign.



• The order for supply of these systems will be executed by two units of BEL at Bengaluru (Karnataka), and Panchkula (Haryana).

IIT-Delhi signed MoU with IAF to improve indigenisation efforts

- IIT-Delhi signed an MoU with Indian Air Force (IAF) to support requirements towards indigenous solutions in various weapon systems.

- It envisages the complete transfer of technology to IRRPL by **Kalashnikov** in the manufacturing of the first 70,000 weapons.
- Rest of the 5.31 lakh weapons will be completely indigenous realizing Govt's vision of Make in India and expanding exports. The whole order will be produced in 10 years

India successfully test-fired the air version of the BrahMos supersonic cruise missile from the integrated test range of Chandipur, off the coast of Odisha. The air version of the missile was test-fired from supersonic fighter aircraft Sukhoi 30 MK-I.



- BrahMos is a joint venture between DRDO (India) and NPO
 Mashinostroyeniya (Russia) for the development, production,
 and marketing of the supersonic cruise missile which has been inducted into the Indian Armed Forces.
- The missile derives its name from the rivers of **Brahmaputra** in India and **Moskva** in Russia.

Sandhayak, 1st of the 4 ships under Survey Vessel (Large) project for Indian Navy, launched at GRSE, Kolkata

- Sandhayak, the first of the four Survey Vessels (Large) Project being built for the Indian Navy (IN) was
 launched in Hooghly River of Kolkata, West Bengal (WB) in the presence of Minister of State (MoS) Ajay
 Bhatt, Ministry of (MoD).
- These Vessels have been designed and developed by Public Sector Undertaking (DPSU), Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE).
- The contract for building four survey ships is priced at Rs 2435 Crores. It was signed between MoD and GRSE on Oct 30, 2018.

The economic stimulus relief package announced by the government is touted to be worth Rs.20 Lakh crores. This includes the already announced Rs 1.70 lakh crore relief package, as the PMGKY, for the poor to overcome difficulties caused by the coronavirus pandemic and the lockdown imposed to check its spread. 
