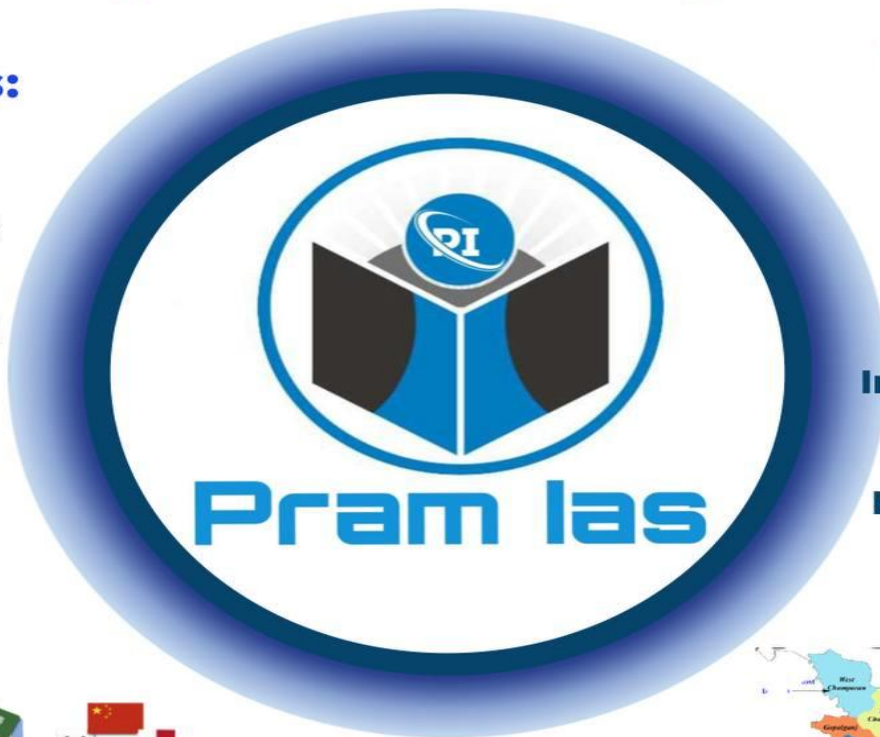

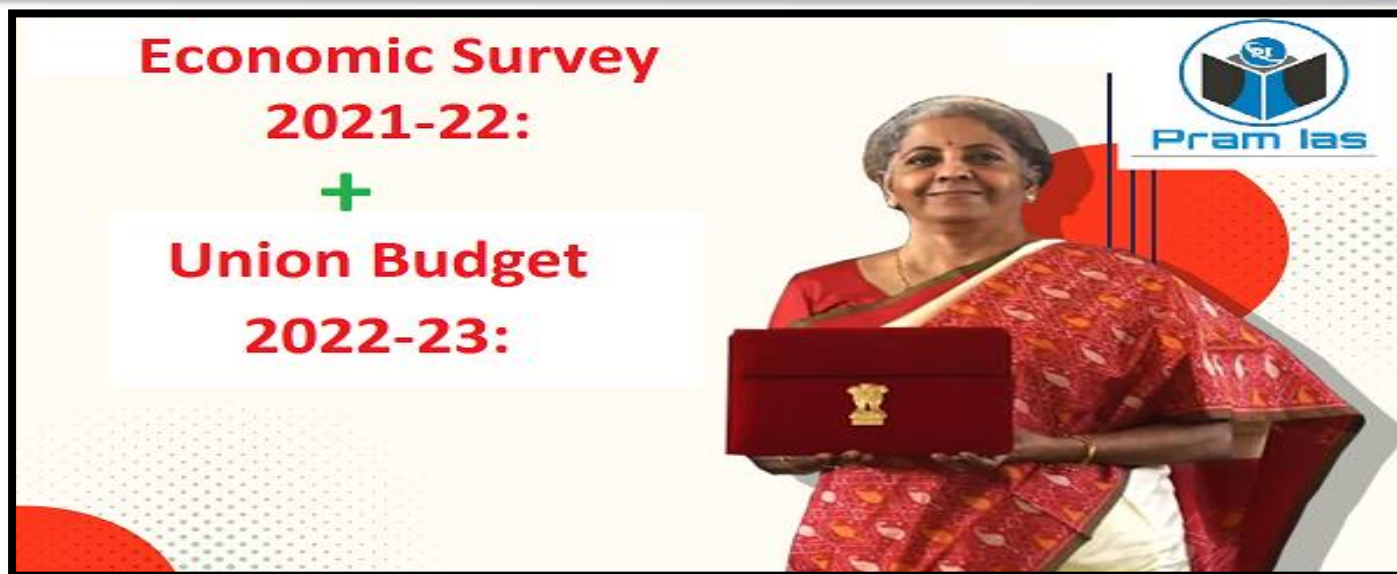

1. Economic Survey 2021-22:

- The government sees the Indian economy growing at **8-8.5 per cent** in the financial year **2022-23 (FY23)**.
- The GDP growth rate for the ongoing financial year **2021-22 (FY22)** is estimated at **9.2 per cent**.
- In order to achieve **USD 5 trillion GDP by FY'25**, India needs to spend about **USD 1.4 trillion** over this period on infrastructure, according to the Economic Survey.
- The theme of Economic Survey 2021-22 is the **"Agile approach"**

State of the Economy:

- Indian economy is estimated to grow by **9.2 per cent** in real terms in 2021-22 (as per first advanced estimates) subsequent to a contraction of **7.3 per cent** in 2020-21.
- GDP is projected to grow by **8- 8.5 per cent** in real terms in 2022-23.
- **Macroeconomic stability indicators suggest that the Indian Economy is well placed to take on the challenges of 2022-23.**

Fiscal Developments:

- The **revenue receipts** from the Central Government (April to November 2021) have gone up by **67.2 per cent** (YoY) as against the expected growth of **9.6 per cent** in the 2021-22 Budget Estimates (over 2020-21 Provisional Actuals).
- Gross Tax Revenue registers a growth of over 50 per cent during April to November 2021 in YoY terms. This performance is strong compared to pre-pandemic levels of 2019-2020 also.
- **During April-November 2021, Capex has grown by 13.5 per cent (YoY) with a focus on infrastructure-intensive sectors.**

External Sectors:

- India's external debt rose to **US \$ 593.1 billion** at the end-September 2021, from the US \$ 556.8 billion a year earlier, reflecting additional SDR allocation by IMF, coupled with higher commercial borrowings.
- **Foreign Exchange Reserves crossed US\$ 600 billion in the first half of 2021-22 and touched the US \$ 633.6 billion as of December 31, 2021.**
- As of end-November 2021, India was the fourth-largest forex reserves holder in the world after China, Japan and Switzerland.

Prices and Inflation:

- The average headline **CPI-Combined inflation moderated to 5.2 per cent** in 2021-22 (April-December) from 6.6 per cent in the corresponding period of 2020-21.

- The decline in retail inflation was led by easing of food inflation.
- **Food inflation** averaged at a low of **2.9 per cent** in 2021-22 (April to December) as against 9.1 per cent in the corresponding period last year.
- **Effective supply-side** management kept prices of most essential commodities under control during the year.

Sustainable Development and Climate Change:

- India's overall score on the **NITI Aayog SDG India Index** and Dashboard improved to 66 in 2020-21 from 60 in 2019-20 and 57 in 2018-19.
- **In North-East India, 64 districts were Front Runners and 39 districts were Performers in the NITI Aayog North-Eastern Region District SDG Index 2021-22.**
- **India has the tenth largest forest area in the world.**
- **In 2020, India ranked third globally in increasing its forest area from 2010 to 2020.**
- In 2020, the forests covered **24%** of India's total geographical, accounting for **2% of the world's total forest area.**
- In August 2021, the **Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021**, was notified which is aimed at **phasing out single-use plastic by 2022.**
- Draft regulation on Extended Producer Responsibility for plastic packaging was notified.
- The consequent reduction in effluent discharge has been from **349.13 million litres per day (MLD) in 2017 to 280.20 MLD in 2020.**
- The Prime Minister, as a part of the national statement delivered at the **26th Conference of Parties (COP 26) in Glasgow** in November 2021, announced ambitious **targets to be achieved by 2030 to enable further reduction in emissions.**
- The need to start the one-word movement '**LIFE**' (Lifestyle for Environment) urging mindful and deliberate utilization instead of mindless and destructive consumption was underlined.

Agriculture and Food Management:

- The Agriculture sector experienced buoyant **growth in past two years**, accounting for a **sizeable 18.8%** (2021-22) in **Gross Value Added (GVA)** of the country registering a growth of **3.6% in 2020-21** and **3.9% in 2021-22.**
- **Minimum Support Price (MSP)** policy is being used to promote **crop diversification.**
- Net receipts from crop production have increased by 22.6% in the latest Situation Assessment Survey (SAS) compared to SAS Report of 2014.
- **Allied sectors** including animal husbandry, dairying and fisheries are steadily emerging to be high growth sectors and major drivers of overall growth in agriculture sector.
- **The Livestock sector** has grown at a CAGR of 8.15% over the last five years ending 2019-20. It has been a stable source of income across groups of agricultural households accounting for about 15% of their average monthly income.
- India runs one of the largest **food management programmes in the world.**
- The government has further extended the coverage of food security networks through schemes like **PM Gareeb Kalyan Yojana (PMGKY).**

Industry and Infrastructure:

- Index of Industrial Production (IIP) grew at 17.4 per cent (YoY) during April-November 2021 as compared to (-)15.3 per cent in April-November 2020.
- **Capital expenditure for the Indian railways has increased to Rs. 155,181 crores in 2020-21 from an average annual of Rs. 45,980 crores during 2009-14 and it has been budgeted to further increase to Rs. 215,058 crores in 2021-22 – a five times increase in comparison to the 2014 level.**
- The extent of road construction per day increased substantially in 2020-21 to 36.5 Kms per day from 28 Kms per day in 2019-20 – a rise of 30.4 per cent.

- Net profit to sales ratio of large corporates reached an all-time high of 10.6 per cent in the July-September quarter of 2021-22 despite the pandemic (RBI Study).
- Introduction of Production Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme, the major boost provided to infrastructure-both physical as well as digital, along with measures to reduce transaction costs and improve ease of doing business, would support the pace of recovery.

Services:

- India has become 3rd largest start-up ecosystem in the world after US and China. The number of new recognized start-ups increased to over 14000 in 2021-22 from 733 in 2016-17.
- 44 Indian start-ups have achieved unicorn status in 2021 taking the overall tally of unicorns to 83, most of which are in the services sector.

Social Infrastructure and Employment:

- **157.94 crore doses** of COVID-19 vaccines administered as on **16th January 2022**; 91.39 crores first dose and 66.05 crores second dose.
- **With the revival of the economy, employment indicators bounced back to pre-pandemic levels during the last quarter of 2020-21.**
- As per the quarterly Periodic Labour Force Survey (PFLS) data up to March 2021, employment in the urban sector affected by pandemic has recovered almost to the pre-pandemic level.
- According to **Employees Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO)** data, formalization of jobs continued during the second COVID wave; the adverse impact of COVID on the formalization of jobs was much lower than during the first COVID wave.
- **Expenditure on social services (health, education and others) by Centre and States as a proportion of GDP increased from 6.2 % in 2014-15 to 8.6% in 2021-22 (BE).**
- Under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM), **83 districts have become 'Har Ghar Jal' districts.**
- Increased allotment of funds to **Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MNREGS)** to provide a buffer for unorganized labour in rural areas during the pandemic.

As per the National Family Health Survey-5:

- **Total Fertility Rate (TFR)** came down to **2 in 2019-21 from 2.2 in 2015-16;**
- **Infant Mortality Rate (IMR), under-five mortality rate and institutional births** have improved in 2019-21 over the year 2015-16.

Union Budget 2022-23

Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman, while presenting the Budget, said that the country is expected to grow at **9.27 per cent.**

- ✎ This Union Budget seeks to lay the foundation & give a blueprint of the economy over '**Amrit Kal**' of next 25 years – from India at 75 to India at 100.
- ✎ Startups will be promoted to facilitate **Drone Shakti** to make drone a service. In select ITIs in all states, courses will be started.
- ✎ Announcement of **Ken Betwa** river linking project worth **Rs 44,605 crore** to be beneficial for capital goods players.
- ✎ Govt continuously encouraging digital banking. Taking forward, **75 digital banking units will be set up in 75 districts.**

- ✗ **Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme** will be extended up to **March 2023** and the guaranteed cover will be expanded by **Rs 50,000 crore** to cover an amount of **Rs 5 lakh crore**.
- ✗ Issuance of **e-passports** will be rolled out in **2022-23** to make it easier for citizens. **Ease of business 2.0** will be launched.
- ✗ **5G spectrum auctions** to be carried out in **calendar 2022** to enable the launch of services within FY22-23.
- ✗ Effective capital expenditure of the Central government is estimated at **Rs 10.68 lakh crore** in 2022-23, about **4.1% of GDP**.
- ✗ To facilitate domestic manufacturing of **280 gigawatts of installed solar capacity by 2030**, an additional allocation of **Rs 19,500 crore** for PLI for manufacturing of high-efficiency modules with priority to fully integrate manufacturing units to solar PV modules will be made.

Tax Proposals:

- ✗ Both Centre and States govt employees' **tax deduction limit** to be increased from **10% to 14%** to help the social security benefits of state government employees and bring them at par with the Central govt employees.
- ✗ Income from transfer of digital assets (**Cryptocurrency**) to be charged **30% tax, plus 1% tax** on the transaction.
- ✗ Corporate **surcharge** to be reduced from **12% to 7%**.
- ✗ Existing tax benefits for startups, which were offered redemption of taxes for **3 consecutive years**, to be **extended by 1 more year**.
- ✗ Income from **Long Term Capital Gains** will be taxed at **15%**.
- ✗ The gross **GST collections for the month of January 2022** are **Rs 1,40,986 crore** —the highest since the inception of the tax.
- ✗ Customs on polished **diamonds, gemstones** cut to **5%**.
- ✗ Deduction for employer contribution to NPS increased to **14% from 10%** earlier for State govt employees on par with central govt employees.
- ✗ Alternate Minimum Tax for **cooperative societies** to be cut to **15%**. The proposal will reduce the surcharge on cooperative societies to **7%**, for those whose income is between **Rs 1 crore and Rs 10 crore**.
- ✗ Unblended fuel to get an additional duty of **2 rupees per litre** from October 2022.
- ✗ Finance Minister announced a reduction of surcharge on unlisted shares from **28.5 per cent to 23 per cent**.

Deficit/Expenditure:

- ✗ **Proposes fiscal deficit** of **4.5% of GDP** by 2025/26
- ✗ **Projects fiscal deficit** of **6.4% of GDP in 2022/23**
- ✗ **Revised** fiscal deficit for 2021/22 at **6.9% of GDP**
- ✗ Total expenditure in 2022/23 seen at **39.45 trillion rupees**
- ✗ States will be allowed **4% fiscal deficit** to GDP in FY23
- ✗ **50 year interest free loans** over and above normal borrowing allocated to states
- ✗ Scheme for financial assistance to states for capital investment outlay to be **1 trillion rupees** in 2022/23

Financial inclusion:

- 100% of **1.5 lakh post offices** will come on the core banking system, enabling financial inclusion and access to accounts through net banking, mobile banking, ATMs, and also providing online transfer of funds between post office accounts and bank accounts.

- This will be helpful especially for farmers and senior citizens in rural areas, enabling interoperability, and financial inclusion.

Fiscal Deficit target set at 6.4% for FY23:

- FY23 total expenditure seen at **Rs 39.45 lakh crore**.
- **Total Receipts** other than borrowing seen at Rs 22.84 lakh crore.
- Revised Fiscal Deficit 6.9% of GDP in FY22 as against 6.8% in Budget estimates.
- Fiscal Deficit target set at **6.4%** for FY23.

National Telehealth programme:

- Sitharaman announced a **National telehealth programme** in Budget 2022. An open platform for the National Digital Health Ecosystem will be rolled out. It will consist of digital registries of health providers and health facilities, unique health identity and universal access to health facilities. The pandemic has accentuated mental health problems in people of all ages.

Education sector:

- States will be encouraged to revise syllabi of **agricultural universities** to meet needs of natural, zero-budget & organic farming, modern-day agriculture. One class, one TV channel' program of **PM eVIDYA** will be expanded from **12 to 200 TV channels**. This will enable all states to provide supplementary education in regional languages for classes **1 to 12**.

Indian Railways:

- **PM Gati Shakti** plans one of the four pillars of growth. **25,000 km** of national highways to be built in **2022-23**.
- **400 new-generation Vande Bharat trains** with higher efficiency and better facilities for passengers will be developed in the next three years. Over 2,000 km of the rail network to be brought under the indigenous world-class technology **KAWACH**, for safety and capacity augmentation.

India's farmers

- Procurement of wheat in Rabi season 2021-22 and the estimated procurement of paddy in Kharif season 2021-22 will cover **1,208 lakh metric tonnes** of wheat and paddy from 163 lakh farmers & **Rs 2.37 lakh crores** will be the direct payment of MSP value to their accounts.
- Chemical-free natural farming to be promoted in India
- **Use of drones** to be promoted for crop assessment, digitization of land records, spraying of insecticides and nutrients. Fund to be facilitated through **NABARD** to finance start-ups for agriculture and rural enterprise which are relevant for the farm produce value chain.

Infrastructure: PM Awas Yojana

- In 2022-23, **80 lakh houses** will be completed for identified beneficiaries of **PM Awas Yojana**; 60,000 houses will be identified as beneficiaries for PM Awas Yojana in rural & urban areas.
- **60,000 crore** allocated for providing access to tap water to 3.8 crore households. In 2022-23, 80 lakh households will be identified for the affordable housing scheme.

Defence:

- **68%** of the capital procurement budget for Defence to be earmarked for domestic industry to promote Aatmanirbharta and reduce dependence on imports.

- This is up from **58%** last fiscal. Defense R&D will be opened up for industry, startups and academia with **25% of the defence R&D budget**.

National Ropeways Development Program:

- National Ropeways Development Program, **Parvatmala** to be taken up on PPP mode.
- Contracts to be awarded in 2022-23 for **8 ropeway projects of 60 Km length**.

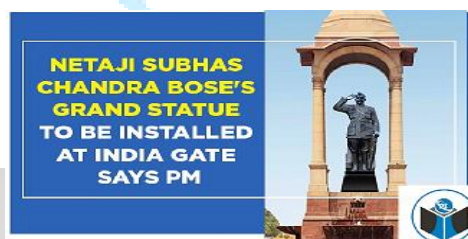
Skill Development:

- **Digital Ecosystem for Skilling and Livelihood (DESH-Stack e-portal)** will be launched to empower citizens to skill, reskill or upskill through on-line training.
- Startups will be promoted to facilitate '**Drone Shakti**' and for **Drone-As-A-Service (DrAAS)**.

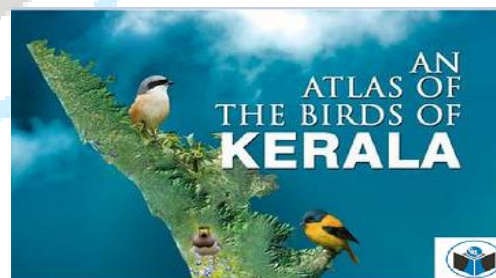
Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose's grand hologram statue installed at India Gate

- Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** has unveiled a grand statue of iconic freedom fighter **Netaji Subhas Chand Bose** at India Gate, New Delhi. The size of the hologram statue is **28 feet in height** and **6 feet in width**.
- A grand statue, which will be made of granite, will **replace the hologram** statue once it is completed. The statue is being installed on the **125th birth anniversary** as **tribute to the immense contribution** of Netaji in the country's freedom struggle and would be a symbol of the country's indebtedness to him.



Kerala got its first-ever scientific bird atlas

- **Kerala Bird Atlas (KBA)**, the **first-of-its-kind State-level bird atlas in India**, has created solid baseline data about the distribution and abundance of bird species across all major habitats, giving an impetus to futuristic studies
- It is being conducted as a citizen science-driven exercise with the participation of over **1,000 volunteers of the birdwatching community** KBA has been prepared based on **systematic surveys held twice over 60 days a year**.



Union Education inister Dharmendra Pradhan has launched a 100-day reading campaign 'Padhe Bharat.

- The launch of the 100 Days Reading Campaign is in alignment with the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020** which lays emphasis on the promotion of joyful reading culture for children

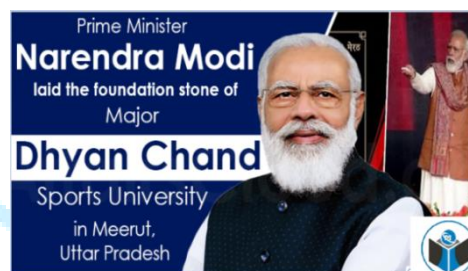


by ensuring the availability of age-appropriate reading books for children in local/mother tongue/regional/tribal language.

- **Padhe Bharat campaign** will focus on children studying in **Balvatika to Grade 8**. The reading campaign will be organized for **100 days (14 weeks)** starting from **January 1, 2022, to April 10, 2022**.
- The reading campaign aims to have the participation of all stakeholders at the national and state level including **children, teachers, parents, community, educational administrators** etc.

PM Modi laid foundation stone of Major Dhyan Chand Sports University in Meerut

- PM Modi laid the foundation stone of **Major Dhyan Chand Sports University** at **Meerut, Uttar Pradesh**.
- The University will be established at **Salawa and Kaili villages** of Sardhana town in Meerut at an estimated cost of about 700 crores.
- The University will have the capacity of training 1080 sportspersons, including 540 female and 540 male sportspersons.



Union Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw launched "India Semiconductor Mission"

- Information Technology Minister **Ashwini Vaishnaw** has launched the **India Semiconductor Mission (ISM)** to attract large investments for setting up semiconductor wafer fabrication facilities in India.
- The companies that are interested are invited by the Centre for the development of the semiconductors and display manufacturing ecosystem in India. ISM is a specialised and independent business division within the Digital India Corporation.
- The financial support of up to **50 per cent** of the project cost (ceiling of Rs 12,000 crore per fab) will be provided for the scheme for setting up display fabs.
- Fiscal support will be provided on '**pari-passu**' basis for a period of six years from the date of approval both for semiconductor fabs and display fabs.



PM chose Puducherry as host of National Youth Festival

- **Puducherry** has been handpicked by Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** to host the **25th National Youth Festival**. The 25th National Youth Festival is going to be held in Puducherry from 12th to 16th January 2022.
- The festival has been organised as part of the **Azadi ki Amrit Mahotsav** marking the 75th year of Independence, said Union Minister for Youth Affairs and Sports and Information and Broadcasting **Anurag Thakur**.



- The festival is likely to draw around 7000 youths in the age group of 18 to 22 from across the country. Around 500 youths from Puducherry will take part in the event.

Ayush Minister lays foundation stone of International Yoga Academy

- Union Ayush minister sarbananda Sonowal has laid the foundation stone of the **Heartfulness International Yoga Academy** in **Hyderabad, Telangana**. He also launched **75 crores suryanamaskar** initiative as part of the **Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav**”.
- The academy tries to reach all levels of society through training programmes and these will be overseen by an international team.



Ladakh celebrated traditional new year 'Losar Festival' of Tibetan Buddhist

- The **Losar Festival** in **Ladakh** is celebrated at the onset of the New Year in the traditional schedule of **Tibetan Buddhism**. It is celebrated by the **Buddhist Community in the Ladakh region**.
- The **Losar** is a **15 days festival**, from the start of the Tibetan Lunar calendar, marking the **1st day of the 11 month** in Tibetan Calendar. Losar is a **Tibetan word that means 'New Year'**.



Telangana topped in highest number of ODF villages

- Telangana** stood first in the country in the list of the **highest number of open defecation-free (ODF Plus) villages** under the **Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) Phase-II** programme till December 31, 2021.
- As many as **13,737** out of **14,200** villages in the State are on the ODF Plus list, which is **96.74%**. This was followed by **Tamil Nadu** with **4,432** villages (**35.39%**) and **Karnataka** with **1,511** villages (**5.59%**). **Gujarat** took the **17th** position with only **83** villages (**0.45%**).



Election Commission hikes expenditure limit for candidates in polls

- The **Election Commission of India** has increased the existing election expenditure limit for candidates in **Parliamentary and Assembly constituencies**, due to the rise in inflation. The new limits will be applicable in all upcoming elections in the country.
- The ceiling on parliamentary poll expenditure has been raised from **70 lakh to 95 lakh** rupees in bigger states and **54 lakh to 75 lakhs** in smaller states.
- The bigger states include **Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal and Karnataka**.
- The smaller states include **Goa, Sikkim, Arunachal Pradesh and UTs**.



- The ceiling on poll expenditure in UT of Jammu and Kashmir has been raised to **95 lakhs**.
- For Assembly constituencies, expenditure limits have been enhanced from **28 lakh rupees to 40 lakh rupees** in bigger states and from **20 lakhs to 28 lakhs** in smaller states.

Rajnath Singh inaugurates Kalpana Chawla Centre For Research at Chandigarh University

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh has inaugurated **Kalpana Chawla Centre for Research in Space Science and Technology (KCCRSST) at Chandigarh University**.
- The Union Minister also launched Chandigarh University's Defence Scholarship Scheme, worth Rs 10 Crore, for the wards of Defence Personnel of the three services. Kalpana Chawla was the first woman of Indian origin to go to space.



India Skills 2021 competition concluded

- **India Skills 2021 national competition** concluded with more than 200 participants who were felicitated by the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship. As many as 270 winners of the Competition felicitated with **61 gold, 77 silver, 53 bronze and 79 medallions** of excellence.
- **Odisha** finished first out of 26 states and union territories of this year in the 'IndiaSkills 2021' contest with 51 medals. Odisha won 10 gold, 18 silver, 9 bronze, and 14 medallions.
- With 30 medals, **Maharashtra** remained in second place, while **Kerala** took third place with 25 medals.
- The winners of the India Skills 2021 competition will also have the opportunity to compete in the **World Skills International Competition in Shanghai, China**, in October 2022.
- The competitions were held at multiple locations, including Pragati Maidan and offsite locations in the National Capital Region, from 7 to 9th of this month.



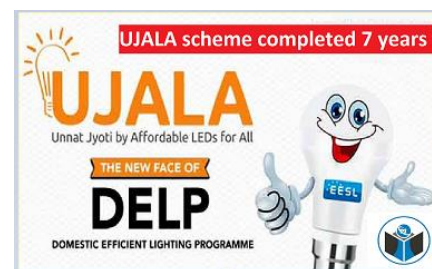
PM Modi inaugurated MSME Technology Centre

- The centre was inaugurated during the inauguration event of the 25th National youth Festival (12th & 13th January 2022) in Puducherry. He also inaugurated the '**Perunthalaivar Kamarajar Manimandapam**', a modern auditorium with an open-air theatre in Puducherry.



UJALA scheme completed 7 years; over 36 crores 70 lakh LEDs distributed across the country so far

- On 5th January 2022, the Power Ministry successfully completed **7 years** of distributing and selling LED lights under its flagship Unnat Jyoti by Affordable LEDs for All (UJALA) programme.
- UJALA initiative is the world's largest zero-subsidy domestic lighting programme with more than 36.78 crore LEDs distributed across the country.



World Food Programme & The Akshaya Patra Foundation partnered to enhance PM POSHAN Scheme

- The **United Nations' World Food Programme (WFP)** in India, has partnered with **The Akshaya Patra Foundation (TAPF)**, a not-for-profit organization, to enhance the effectiveness of the Pradhan Mantri – Poshan Shakti Nirman (**PM POSHAN**) scheme (earlier known as National Programme for Mid-Day Meal in Schools).
- Aim:** The partnership aims to enhance food safety and hygiene projects, capacity building of cooks-cum-helpers and nutritional quality of school meals.
- Under this collaboration, WFP and TAPF will share knowledge through workshops and policy and strategy dialogues with the government to enhance the quality of the school meal programme.



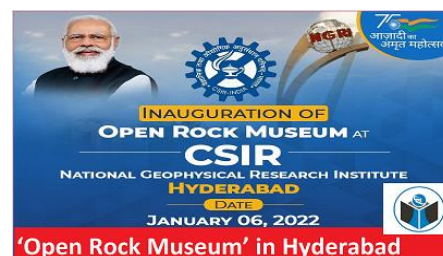
Kerala High Court became India's 1st paperless court

- The **Kerala High Court** is all set to become **India's first paperless court**. Supreme Court judge Justice **DY Chandrachud** inaugurated the smart courtrooms on **1 January 2022**.
- In the **1st phase six courtrooms, including the Chief Justice's room, will be converted into smart courts**. Also, case files will be made available to the lawyers on the computer screen.



Science & Technology minister inaugurated India's first & unique 'Open Rock Museum' in Hyderabad

- Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology Dr. Jitendra Singh inaugurated India's **first & unique 'Open Rock Museum'** at the campus of Council of Scientific & Industrial Research – **National Geophysical Research Institute (CSIR-NGRI)**, Hyderabad, Telangana.
- The Open Rock Museum displays around 35 different types of rocks from different parts of India with ages ranging from 3 Billion years to around 55 Million years of the Earth's history.
- The Rock Museum aims at educating the masses about several lesser-known facts about the Rocks



Odisha's Ganjam district was declared child marriage-free

- **Odisha's Ganjam district** was declared **child marriage-free** with effect from **January 3, 2022**, after collecting detailed information about all weddings that took place in 2020 and 2021.
- Ganjam district administration has increased the **reward for people informing about the occurrence of child marriage** to **Rs 50,000 from Rs 5,000**.
- **Ganjam is the 1st district** in the state that has been declared child marriage-free. The district has been known to be severely affected by child marriages
- Ganjam had started a programme **Nirbhaya Kadhi (Fearless bud)** to inform the administration about the occurrence of child marriage.



Kochi became India's first city to have a Water Metro Project

- **Kochi, Kerala** has become **India's first city to have a Water Metro Project** after the launch of its first boat in December 2021, namely '**Muziris**,' among the 23 battery-powered electric boats being manufactured by Cochin Shipyard Limited.
- This launch is a part of Rs 747-crore project which is operated by Kochi Water Metro Ltd (KWML). The boats will be called Water Metros.
- With a total outlay of Rs 819 crore, project's major part is financed under Indo-German Financial Cooperation through a long-term loan agreement of 85 million Euros (Rs 579 crore) with German funding agency, KfW (Kreditanstalt für Wiederaufbau).



India's oldest sloth bear 'Gulabo' died at Van Vihar National Park, Bhopal

- **India's oldest female sloth bear, named Gulabo**, died at the **Van Vihar National Park and Zoo in Bhopal**, Madhya Pradesh.
- Gulabo was the oldest sloth bear of the country. She died at the age of 40. She was rescued from a street performer (Madaari) in May 2006, when she was 25 years.
- The Van Vihar National Park, located on the banks of Bhopal's Upper Lake, also runs a rescue and breeding centre for sloth bears.

India's 1st Heli-Hub to be set up in Gurugram, Haryana

- The government of Haryana in collaboration with the Ministry of Civil Aviation is set to establish India's first-ever Heli Hub in Gurugram.
- The **first of its kind heli-hub** in Gurugram is designed to all the facilities in one place for Helicopters.
- The hub will have several aviation facilities like Heliport, Hangars, repairs and other related services. The hub will be developed in 10-20 acres of land well connected with Dwarka Expressway and National Highway (NH) 8.



Indian Railway has launched "Mission Amanat" to help passengers track their lost belongings

- The **Railway Protection Force (RPF)** of the **Western Railways zone of Indian Railways** has launched a new initiative called "**Mission Amanat**" to make it easier for railway passengers to get back their lost luggage.
- Under Mission Amanat, the **details of lost luggage and belongings along with photos will be uploaded on the official website** of the zonal railway, <https://wr.indianrailways.gov.in/>.



- This will help the passengers in tracking and getting back their lost belongings as well as ensure the safety and security of passengers and their luggage and belongings.

Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav released India State of Forest Report 2021

- Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav has released the biennial India **State of Forest Report 2021**.
- Total forest and tree cover in India in 2021 is **80.9 million hectares (8,09,537 sq. km)**. This is **24.62%** of the geographical area of the country.
- Forest and tree cover in India has risen by 2,261 square Kilometers (sq km) in 2 years (compared to 2019).
- 17 states and union territories have above 33% of the geographical area under forest cover.
- **Largest forest cover:** Madhya Pradesh
- **Maximum increase in forest cover:** Andhra Pradesh
- **Total carbon stock in India's forest:** 7,204 million tonnes



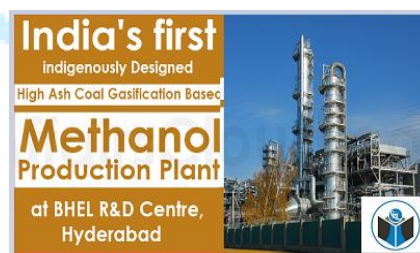
World's largest Khadi National Flag displayed at Longewala in Jaisalmer

- **World's largest national flag**, made of Khadi fabric was put to display to celebrate the "Army Day" on **January 15, 2022**.
- It was displayed at **Longewala**, along the India – Pakistan Border in **Jaisalmer**. Longewala was the centre stage of historic battle of 1971 between India and Pakistan. It will be the fifth public display of the Khadi flag.
- The Monumental National Flag is 225 feet long and 150 feet wide. It is approximately 1400 kgs in weight. 70 khadi artisans prepared this flag in 49 days. Its making has created about 3500 man-hours of additional work for Khadi artisans and allied workers.
- 4500 meters of hand-woven, hand-spun, Khadi cotton bunting has been used to make the flag. It covers an area of 33,750 square feet. The Ashoka Chakra in the flag has a diameter of 30 feet.



India's first coal to methanol plant built by BHEL inaugurated in Hyderabad

- Union government has dedicated India's **first BHEL-built 'coal to methanol' (CTM) pilot plant to the nation in Hyderabad**.
- The 0.25 TPD capacity CTM pilot plant is currently producing methanol with purity of more than 99% from high-ash coal.
- This conversion of high-ash Indian coal to methanol through the gasification route is the first-of-its-kind technology demonstration in India.



16th India Digital Summit 2022 organised by IAMAI

- **Piyush Goyal**, Union Minister of Commerce & Industry, addressed the **16th edition of India Digital Summit, 2022** through a video conference.
- The two-day virtual event was organised on January 11 and 12, 2022 by the **Internet And Mobile Association of India (IAMAI)** with the theme "Supercharging Startups".
- During the event, the Minister unveiled 'LEAP' (Leverage, Encourage, Access & Promote) as the way forward to further strengthen our Startups ecosystem.



Cabinet approved infusion of Rs. 1,500 crores in Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency Limited

- ✎ The Union Cabinet approved the infusion of **1500 crores rupees in the Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency Limited (IREDA)**.
- It will help generate 10,200 jobs a year and reduce carbon emissions equivalent to approximately 7.49 million tonnes per year. The IREDA played a big role in the field of renewable energy and its portfolio had increased from ₹8,800 crore to ₹28,000 crores in the past six years.



Indian Army signs first contract with private sector

- In a significant step towards achieving **self-reliance** in the defence sector, the Indian Army signed its **first contract worth Rs 96 crore with Anadron Systems Pvt Ltd** under Make-II for Maneuverable Expendable Aerial Target.
- It also represents a significant step towards the 'AtmaNirbhar' initiative, which is aimed at making India a self-reliant nation.
- The industry funded projects that fall under the 'Make-II' category include prototype development of equipment and their upgrades and sub-systems.



PM Modi to host first meeting of India-Central Asia Summit:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will be hosting **the first meeting of the India-Central Asia Summit** in a virtual format on 27th January.
- Presidents of **Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan** will participate.
- This will be the first engagement of its kind between India and the Central Asian countries at the level of leaders.
- The first India-Central Asia Summit is a reflection of India's growing engagement with the Central Asian countries, which are a part of India's **"Extended Neighbourhood"**.



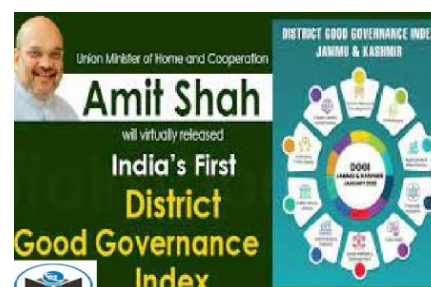
India's 1st para-badminton academy launched in Lucknow

- India's **first state-of-the-art, high-performance para-badminton academy with advanced equipment and facilities** has been set up in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.
- The set-up will improve **India's medal prospects** at the **2024 Paralympics** to be held in **Paris, France** at **Stade de France stadium**.
- The badminton centre has been **launched by the head national coach of the Indian para-badminton team, Gaurav Khanna**, in association with **Ageas Federal Life Insurance**. He also unveiled the **Ageas Federal 'Quest for Fearless Shuttler programme** to spot and nurture new talent for the **2028 and 2032 Paralympics**.



India's First "District Good Governance Index" for 20 Districts released

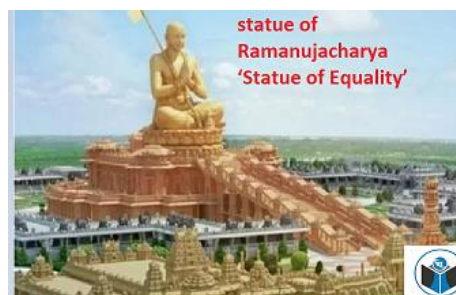
- Union Home Minister Amit Shah has released **India's First District Good Governance Index** for 20 Districts of UT of Jammu and Kashmir.
- The **top 5 districts** in the District Good Governance Index" are **Jammu, Doda, Samba, Pulwama and Srinagar**. J&K will become the first Union Territory in the country to have a Good Governance Index.



- The index was prepared by the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG) and Jammu & Kashmir Institute of Management, Public Administration & Rural Development in association with the Centre for Good Governance, Hyderabad.

PM Modi will inaugurate 216-foot statue of Ramanujacharya 'Statue of Equality' in Hyderabad

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate a **216-foot statue of Ramanujacharya** in a sitting position in **Hyderabad** on Feb 5, 2022, to celebrate the **1,000th birth anniversary** of the saint.
- Ramanujacharya was an 11th-century saint and a revolutionary social reformer. The statue will be called as '**Statue of Equality**'.
- It is located in a **45-acre complex at Shamshabad** on the outskirts of **Hyderabad, Telangana**. It is **built at a cost of 1,000 crore**, which was funded entirely by donations



India participated in 'Sea Dragon' 2022 exercise at Guam in the Western Pacific

- India is participating in the multinational exercise Sea Dragon the United States, Australia, Canada, India, Japan and South Korea.
- The exercise, **primarily focused on anti-submarine warfare (ASW) training**, will involve more than 270 hours of in-flight training and activities ranging from tracking simulated targets to tracking a US Navy submarine. Each event will be graded and the country scoring the highest points will receive the Dragon Belt award.



Defence Minister announced 27 Border Infrastructure Projects

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh listed the development of critical border infrastructure as a key priority to boost India's overall defence and security system.
- He announced **24 bridge projects** and **3 road projects** implemented and managed by the **Border Roads Organisation (BRO)** in four states and two union territories.
- Out of the **24 bridges**, nine are in Jammu and Kashmir, five each in Ladakh and Himachal Pradesh, three in Uttarakhand and one each in Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh. Out of the **3 road projects**, two are in Ladakh and one is in West Bengal.

PI-When you saw your result what was your reaction and how did you feel?

Sweta:- It was 7th Oct 2021, the first day of Navratri and I was very anxious. The result was supposed to be announced in the evening but to everyone’s surprise it came in the afternoon. I randomly checked my phone and voila...Rank 33rd. My hands were shaking and I started crying. My mother came running towards me and we hugged each other. That moment was a bliss and the feeling very surreal.



PI-To whom you want to give credit for your success?

Sweta:- I would like to give credit to my whole family but especially my mother. She instilled this interest for reading since my childhood. Also, I would like to thank my friends who were there with me.

PI-How and when did you decide you want to be a civil servant?

Sweta:- It was Dec 2012 when the whole country was raged over the “Delhi Nirbhaya Case”. And I wanted to march on the street like everyone else. My mother seeing my outrage said “system ka part banker use badalne ki koshish kro, sirf bahar khade rehkar mat chillao”. This line hit me like a bullet and I decided to serve the society and help the needy. A teenager in Class 11th, preparing for JEE decided to become a civil servant then.

PI-During the preparation, what was the most challenging thing that you faced and how did you overcome it?

Sweta:- The most challenging part was the “self-doubt”. I had exam fear and considered the exam to be “larger than life”. I used to put in 12-14hrs daily and hardly took breaks. After failing in UPSC Prelims 2019 I re-strategized and started taking break every week. I started working out, going on a walk every day. Basically I started taking some time out for

myself and it helped me gain a lot of confidence. The same year in October I wrote 65th BPSC prelims and cracked it.

PI-How did you keep yourself motivated and what would you suggest others?

Sweta:- What kept me motivated was that I knew the answer to my “WHY”. As long as you know why you’re doing it you would keep on going. I did not cut myself from my friends. I used to hangout with them, talk my heart out, express my insecurities and vulnerabilities.

I would like to suggest others to not keep their feelings to themselves. Talk to people you’re comfortable with. Be it your partner, friends, family or a counsellor. Just don’t keep yourself in a box. This exam is mentally taxing. As a civil servant, you’re expected to be “**HUMANS**” and not “**ROBOTS**”.

PI-What was your optional and how did you prepare it?

Sweta:- My optional subject was ANTHROPOLOGY. I started its preparation using UPSC topper Anudeep Durishetty Sir’s strategy. I followed it step by step and bought the books and did self-study. My sources were:
Social Anthropology- Braintree, Madan & Majumdar
Physical Anthropology- P. Nath
Indian Anthropology- Nadeem Hasnain+ case studies
Followed pyq and prepared model answers of few important questions. Do incorporate case studies in your answers for good marks.

PI-Can you tell us about your interview experience?

Sweta:- My interview was on 17th August 2021, first slot, Imtiaz Sir board. It was my first civil services interview and I was very nervous. I was 6th to go to the board. All the questions asked were in hindi and I answered in the same language. I was polite and maintained a smile on my face and also apologised if I did not know answers. My interview lasted for 20-25minutes. I got decent 82marks in my interview.

PI-Any suggestion for the future civil servants regarding preparation process.

Sweta:- Keep yourself motivated. The life spent in the pursuit of knowledge is worth living. You all are preparing for civil services, try to incorporate the qualities in yourself during the process itself. Wear it as a badge of honour. Be proud of your decision and work hard to achieve your goal. If not in 2022 then in 2023 but you would achieve it one day.

4. INTERNATIONAL NEWS

France took over European Union Presidency for six months till June 30 2022

- France has assumed the rotating presidency of the **Council of the European Union** with effect from **January 01, 2022**.
- The country will continue to hold the **EU presidency for the next six months till June 30, 2022**. This is the **13th time** that France has taken over the rotating presidency. The motto of France as EU President is “**recovery, strength, belonging.**” Upon the completion of six months presidency, France will be replaced by the **Czech Republic**.



Antigua and Barbuda joined International Solar Alliance as 102nd member

- The Caribbean nation of **Antigua and Barbuda** joined the **International Solar Alliance (ISA)** as the **102nd member** by signing the **International Solar Alliance Framework Agreement**, the India-led global green energy initiative.
- The **Prime Minister of Antigua and Barbuda, Gaston Browne** signed the framework agreement in the presence of Indian High Commissioner Dr K. J. Srinivasa to catalyze global energy transition through a solar-led approach.
- ISA was jointly launched by **India and France** in **2015** during the **21st session of the United Nations Climate Change COP-21 in Paris, France** to promote solar energy.

Japan & Australia signed defense agreement to counter China

- **Japan and Australia** signed a ‘landmark’ defense treaty named the **Reciprocal Access Agreement (RAA)** to counter China’s expansionary military and economic policies.
- The treaty or RAA will enhance the interoperability and co operation between the two countries. It is the **second deal signed between Japan & Australia after Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (QUAD)**.
- The treaty was signed between **Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison** and **Japanese PM Fumio Kishida** in a virtual conference organized in Tokyo, Japan.



Indo US Trade- Commerce gets a fillip with improving Agri Market Access:

- **12th India – USA TPF meeting held, Department of Agriculture and farmer's welfare (DAC&FW) and US Department of Agriculture (USDA) have signed a framework agreement for implementing the 2 Vs 2 Agri market access issues i.e inspection / oversight transfer for Indian mangoes & pomegranate and market access for pomegranate arils from India and market access for US cherries and U.S Alfalfa hay.**
- **Mango and pomegranate exports will start from Jan – Feb 2022 and pomegranate aril exports from Apr 2022.**
- **Exports of Alfalfa hay and cherries from USA will begin in Apr 2022.**
- **In addition, based on the ministerial discussions, Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (DAHD) also conveyed its readiness to provide market access for U.S pork and requested the U.S side to share a signed copy of final sanitary certificate for finalizing the same.**



India, South Korea agree to impart 'fresh momentum' in CEPA up-gradation talks:

- **India stressed the need for fast-tracking the upgradation process of the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) with South Korea and raised issues of concern such as the large trade deficit and industry's demand for greater market access and lower non-tariff barriers.**
- **India's exports from South Korea in 2020-21 were at \$4.2 billion while imports from the country were at \$9.5 billion.**
- **New Delhi has been complaining about Indian businesses gaining far less from the CEPA than their South Korean counterparts and the need for up-gradation of the pact in a way that favours India and reduces the trade gap.**



India-US agree to advance cooperation in counter-terrorism, cyber security among other issues:

- **The Senior Officers Meeting of the India-US Homeland Security Dialogue was held in virtual mode.**
- **The meeting was co-chaired by Home Secretary Ajay Bhalla and Under Secretary for Strategy, Policy and Plans, Department of Homeland Security, Government of USA, Robert Silvers.**
- **During the meeting, both sides reviewed the ongoing cooperation and identified further steps that can be taken to explore opportunities and synergies in advancing cooperation in counter-terrorism, cyber security, securing critical infrastructure, maritime security and aviation security among other issues.**
- **During the meeting, both sides agreed that the existing sub-groups under the Homeland Security Dialogue on law enforcement engagement, securing global supply chains, investigative cooperation, and capacity building would meet separately in the coming months.**



- It will deliberate and explore how ongoing cooperation can be strengthened further.

India and UK Launch Free Trade Agreement Negotiations:

- The Minister of Commerce and Industry, Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution and Textiles, Shri Piyush Goyal launched the Free Trade Agreement negotiations with the United Kingdom along with Rt. Hon. Anne Marie Trevelyan, UK Secretary of State for International Trade in New Delhi.
- The FTA is expected to facilitate the target of doubling bilateral trade between India and United Kingdom by 2030, set by the Prime Ministers of both the nations, Shri Narendra Modi and Mr. Boris Johnson in May 2021.



PM and new German Chancellor express hope of cooperation initiatives in areas of Climate Action and Green Energy:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Federal Chancellor of Germany Olaf Scholz have agreed on further diversifying cooperation and exchanges in new areas including Climate Action and Green Energy.
- Prime Minister Modi held a telephonic conversation with Mr Scholz and congratulated him on his appointment as the German Chancellor.
- Modi expressed his appreciation for the immense contribution of former Chancellor Angela Merkel in strengthening the India-Germany Strategic Partnership and looked forward to continuing this positive momentum under the leadership of Mr Scholz.



Russia's test-fires new hypersonic Tsirkon missiles 2022

- Russia successfully test-fired around 10 new Tsirkon (Zircon) hypersonic cruise missiles from a frigate and other two missiles from a submarine.
- The Zircon missile would be capable of flying at nine times the speed of sound and have a range of 1,000 kilometres (620 miles).
- The Tsirkon Cruise Missile will join Avangard glide vehicles and the air-launched Kinzhal (Dagger) missiles in Russia's hypersonic arsenal.
- Zircon is intended to arm Russian cruisers, frigates and submarines. It is one of several hypersonic missiles under development in Russia. The launch was the latest in a series of tests of Zircon, which is set to enter service next year.



Apple becomes world's first company to hit \$3 trillion M-Cap

- The stock market value of **Apple Inc.** hit **\$3 trillion** and became the world's first company to do so. The market cap of Apple hit **\$182.86 per share**, which made it **the world's first company to touch the \$3 trillion mark**.
- However shortly after hitting the mark, the share value dipped below it and did not rise again until the market closed. The iPhone maker passed **\$2 trillion** in 2020 and over **\$1 trillion** in 2018.
- The world's most valuable company reached the milestone as investors bet that consumers will continue to shell out top dollar for iPhones, MacBooks and services such as Apple TV and Apple Music.
- In China, the world's largest smartphone market, Apple continued to lead for the second straight month, beating rivals such as Vivo and Xiaomi, recent data from CounterPoint Research showed.



India give support to Sri Lanka to overcome forex crisis

- India** has announced financial assistance of **USD 900 million loans** to **Sri Lanka** to help the island nation in building up its depleted foreign reserves and for food imports. It must be noted that Sri Lanka is currently facing a shortage of almost all essential commodities due to a shortage of dollars to pay for the imports.
- India is extending its support through the **Reserve Bank of India (RBI)**. The Indian High Commissioner to Sri Lanka Gopal Baglay met Cabraal and expressed India's strong support to Sri Lanka in the wake of RBI extending over USD 900 million facilities.
- These comprise deferment of **Asian Clearing Union** settlement of over **USD 509 million** and currency swap of **USD 400 million**.



Narayan Rane virtually inaugurates MSME Pavilion in World Expo, 2020 Dubai:

- Union Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Minister, **Narayan Rane** has virtually inaugurated **MSME Pavilion in World Expo, 2020 Dubai**.
- The **World Expo 2020**, held under the Bureau International des Expositions aims at bringing together millions of people for the world's exceptional show, celebrating human brilliance and achievement with the theme **"Connecting Minds, Creating Future"**.



- The **MSME Ministry's participation in the Expo** will help to develop an understanding of the MSME ecosystem in India as well as enable interaction with governments of different countries, Business and Industry leaders, which will help in exchange for best practices adopted across the world.
- Rane also launched the **Khadi India Film produced by KVIC**.
- It has over six crore units employing over **11 crore** people and is a significant contributor to the economic growth of India

Abu Dhabi Airport Drone Attack:

- Three persons including two Indian nationals were killed in an explosion at Mussafah in United Arab Emirates (UAE) near Abu Dhabi National Oil Company ADNOC's storage tanks.
- The fuel tank explosion was triggered by a drone attack carried out by Yemen's Huthi rebels.
- Three petrol tanks exploded near a storage facility, while a fire also engulfed a construction area at Abu Dhabi airport.
- The United Arab Emirates is part of a Saudi-led military coalition that supports Yemen's government against the Iran-backed Huthi rebels.
- While Houthi rebels claimed responsibility for the attack, UAE Foreign Minister Abdullah bin Zayed Al-Nahyan said that the sinful targeting will not go unpunished.

India & Denmark agree to work together on green fuels including green hydrogen:

- India & Denmark agreed to initiate joint research and development on **green fuels including green hydrogen**, during the Joint S&T Committee meeting on 14th January 2022.
- The committee emphasised on **development of bilateral collaboration** on mission-driven research, innovation, and technology development, including climate and green transition, energy, water, waste, food, and so on as agreed by the two Prime Ministers while adopting the **Green Strategic Partnership – Action Plan 2020-2025**.



Joint inauguration and launch of projects by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister of Mauritius Pravind Kumar Jugnauth:

- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister of Mauritius Pravind Kumar Jugnauth will jointly inaugurate the **India-assisted Social Housing Units project in Mauritius** virtually on 20 January, 2022.
- The two dignitaries will also launch the **Civil Service College and 8MW Solar PV Farm projects in Mauritius** that are being undertaken under India's development support.



5. Defence News

Defence Minister announced 27 Border Infrastructure Projects

- Defence Minister Rajnath Singh listed the development of critical border infrastructure as a key priority to boost India's overall defence and security system.
- He announced **24 bridge projects** and **3 road projects** implemented and managed by the **Border Roads Organisation (BRO)** in four states and two union territories.
- Out of the **24 bridges**, nine are in Jammu and Kashmir, five each in Ladakh and Himachal Pradesh, three in Uttarakhand and one each in Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh. Out of the **3 road projects**, two are in Ladakh and one is in West Bengal.



DRDO successfully test-fired naval variant of BrahMos supersonic cruise missile from INS Visakhapatnam

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully test-fired an **extended range sea-to-sea variant** of the **BrahMos supersonic cruise missile** from **INS Visakhapatnam**, a stealth guided-missile destroyer of the Indian Navy.
- BrahMos Aerospace**, an **India-Russian joint venture**, produces supersonic cruise missiles that can be launched from submarines, ships, aircraft, or land platforms.
- The missile can be launched from **submarines, ships, aircraft, or land platforms**. BrahMos missile **flies at a speed of 2.8 Mach** or almost three times the speed of sound.



Recent Tests by DRDO:

- Indigenously developed helicopter-launched **stand-off anti-tank (SANT)** missile
- Extended Range **Pinaka rocket system (Pinaka-ER)**
- Area Denial Munitions (ADM)** and indigenously developed **fuzes**
- Air version of the BrahMos** supersonic cruise missile from **Sukhoi 30 MK-I** aircraft
- Indigenously-developed **Smart Anti-Airfield Weapon (SAAW)**
- Indigenously-designed **Abhyas – High-speed Expendable Aerial Target (HEAT)**

DRDO successfully test-fired MPATGM in its final "deliverable configuration"

- Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully flight tested the final deliverable configuration of the **Man-Portable Anti-Tank Guided Missile (MPATGM)** at a range in Southern India.
- It is **indigenously developed anti-tank missile low weight**



(15kg), fire and forget missile and is launched from a man portable launcher, integrated with thermal sight.

- MPATGM will be **manufactured by Bharat Dynamics Limited** at its facility in **Bhanoor, Telangana**. The purpose of testing the missile was to check its consistent performance at a minimum range, which is **200-300 metres**.
- **MPATGM** has already completed a similar successful test for a **maximum range of 4,000 metres**. With this successful test of the MPATGM, the system is now ready for production in large numbers in India.

Philippines became 1st country to buy BrahMos supersonic cruise missile for \$374.96 million

- **Philippines** has become the **first foreign country** to place an order for the **purchase of the BrahMos** Shore-Based cruise Missile System for its navy. This agreement will give a big boost to India’s defence manufacturing system.
- The estimated deal cost is worth **\$374.9 million**.
- The **BrahMos Aerospace Pvt Ltd** will supply the missile, under the **Shore-Based Anti-Ship Missile System Acquisition Project**, for **Philippine Navy**.



ISRO successfully conducted qualification tests of Cryogenic Engine for Gaganyaan

- **Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO)** successfully conducted the **qualification test of Cryogenic Engine** for **Gaganyaan** programme for a duration of **720 seconds** at **ISRO Propulsion Complex, Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu**.
- The Qualification test ensures the **reliability and robustness of the cryogenic engine** for induction into the human-rated launch vehicle for Gaganyaan.
- India’s 1st human space mission ‘**Gaganyaan**’ will be launched in 2023. With this launch, India will become the **4th nation** in the world to launch a Human Spaceflight Mission after the USA, Russia and China



India launches 41st Scientific Expedition to Antarctica

- India successfully launched the 41st Scientific Expedition to Antarctica on November 15, 2021. The first batch of its contingents comprising of 23 scientists and support staff has reached the Indian Antarctic station Maitri. Four more batches will be landing in Antarctica by mid-January
- 2022. The Indian Antarctic program began in 1981 and has completed 40 scientific expeditions.



India's bases at Antarctica

There are three permanent research base stations in Antarctica, named Dakshin Gangotri (1983), Maitri (1988) and Bharati (2012), currently, Maitri and Bharati are fully operational.

- **Dakshin Gangotri**—India's first scientific base station in Antarctica established in 1983 as a part of Indian Antarctica Programme.
- **Maitri**—This is the 2nd permanent research station which is also known as the Friendship Research Centre, launched by India in 1988.
- **Bharati**—This is the 3rd permanent and active research station in Antarctica established in 2012.

ISRO successfully tested liquid propellant-based Vikas engine for Gaganyaan mission

- **Indian Space Research Organisation** has successfully conducted a 25-second qualification test for its liquid propellant-based High Thrust Vikas engine which is to be used under the Gaganyaan mission.
- The test was conducted **at the ISRO Propulsion Complex in Mahendragiri, Tamil Nadu.**
- The test was done **to test the performance of the engine in optimal conditions**, such as a change in the fuel-oxidiser ratio or pressure in the fuel chamber.
- These engines will be used in the **launch vehicles which will carry Indian astronauts to space in 2023.**



Indian Armed Force selected 'Saab' for supply of Anti-Armour weapon AT4

- **Swedish defence company 'Saab'** had been selected by the **Indian Armed Force** through a competitive programme for the **supply of single-shot anti-armour weapon AT4.**
- AT4 will be **used by the Indian Army and the Indian Air Force.** AT4 will be operated by a single soldier and its single-shot system has proven efficacy against structures landing craft helicopters armoured vehicles and personnel.
- The order includes the **AT4CS AST**, which can be fired from confined spaces such as from inside buildings, bunkers and other urban environments. **Carl-Gustaf system of Saab** is being already used by the Indian Armed Forces.



Amar Jawan Jyoti eternal flame merged with National War Memorial flame

- The government of India has merged the **Amar Jawan Jyoti flame** at India Gate with the flame at the **newly constructed National War Memorial** in the same complex.
- The ceremony was led by the **Integrated Defence Staff chief, Air Marshal Balabadhra Radha Krishna.**
- The **decision to merge the two flames** was taken keeping in mind that flame at **Amar Jawan Jyoti paid homage to the**



martyrs of 1971 operations that led to **the freedom of Bangladesh**, but none of their names are present there, while names of all Indian martyrs from all the wars, **including 1971 and wars before and after it are housed at the National War Memorial**.

- So, housing the flame at the same place along with the names will serve as a true tribute to martyrs.

India successfully test-fired a new version of BrahMos supersonic cruise missile

- **BrahMos supersonic cruise missile** with increased **indigenous content and improved performance** was **successfully test fired** from **Integrated Test Range**, Chandipur off the coast of Odisha
- The **launch** was conducted by **Brahmos Aerospace** in close coordination with the teams of the **Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO)**.
- The missile was equipped with **advanced indigenous technologies** and followed a modified optimal trajectory for enhanced efficiency and improved performance.
- BrahMos is the **main weapon system of the Indian Navy warships**. An **underwater version is also being developed** which will be used by the submarines of India.



Jio signed a pact with Finland's University of Oulu to accelerate 6G research

- **Jio Platforms (JPL)** signed a pact with the **University of Oulu, Finland**, to **accelerate research and standardization in 6G technology**.
- JPL and the University of Oulu will collaborate in **Research and Development (R&D)** of aerial and space communication, holographic beamforming, 3D-connected intelligence in cybersecurity, microelectronics, and photonics.
- The collaboration will **develop competency with 6G enabled products** in the defence, automotive, white goods, industrial machinery, consumer goods, efficient manufacturing, novel personal smart device environments, and experiences such as urban computing and autonomous traffic settings.

- On the eve of the country's 73rd Republic Day, the Union Ministry of Home Affairs announced the Padma awards.
- Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan, and Padma Shri** are the **three categories of Padma awards**. The award is intended to reward accomplishments in all professions or disciplines where public service is a factor.
- President has authorised the **conferment of 128 Padma Awards**, including two duo cases (the Award is considered as one in a dual case).
- There are **four Padma Vibhushan awards, seventeen Padma Bhushan awards, and 107 Padma Shri awards** on the list. There are **34 women among the awardees**, as well as **10 foreigners/NRI/PIO/OCI and 13 posthumous** recipients.
